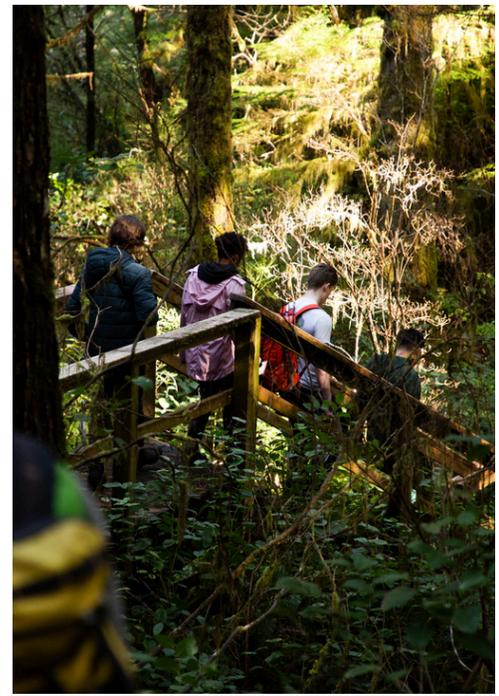


PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Aspengrove Elite Junior Golf Program is designed to develop high-performing student-athletes through a year-round training system. Our goal is to support juniors in achieving competitive success, personal growth, and preparation for collegiate-level golf.

Aspengrove has a partnership with Morningstar Golf Club, a golf course designed in 1991 to host competitive tournaments. Morningstar offers a year-round membership for our Juniors that allows playing privileges on the golf course, a grass tee driving range, three short game areas and an indoor academy for year-round training. Through extensive coaching and access to a premiere facility, Aspengrove aspires to help cultivate the top junior golfers not only in BC, but in Canada.


MORNING STAR GOLF COURSE

Morningstar, a championship golf course designed by Canadian architect Les Furber in 1991, features wide fairways, large undulating greens, and four tee options per hole, making it enjoyable for all skill levels. The course has hosted numerous top-level events, including PGA of Canada tournaments, CN Future Links Pacific Championships, Golf Canada national championships, and the BC Golf Junior Championships. Aspengrove golfers are fortunate to use this outstanding facility as part of their program.



RAVENS NEST ATHLETICS CENTRE AT ASPENGROVE

PROGRAM GOALS

Annual Schedule Overview

Fall (Sept–Oct): Foundation & team culture, technical refinement, physical screening, goal setting, on-course strategy.

Winter (Nov–Feb): Skill & physical development, indoor training, speed training, golf swing mechanics, strength & mobility, swing analysis.

Spring (Mar–April): Performance season prep, on-course practice, mental performance, tournament readiness, course mapping, shot selection, wedge practice/distance control, short game.

Summer (May–June): Competition & peak performance; tournament play, travel coaching, post-tournament individualized feedback, strokes lost/gained analysis.

Tournament Scheduling

Aspengrove focuses on preparing and taking our students to competitive regional and provincial events that qualify them for Canadian National events, World Juniors and earn World Ranking Points. Events through BC Golf and our Zone 6 Spring/Summer Tour, BC Junior Qualifiers and BC Summer Games Qualifiers, Golf Canada NEXT GEN Events as well as Maple Leaf Junior Tour world qualifiers.

Tyler has developed numerous competitive junior golfers, coaching students to over 30 regional and provincial championship wins, multiple World Junior and National Championship appearances, and several collegiate golf scholarships. Tyler is also an experienced program leader and mentor. He has hired and trained instructional teams, designed coach development plans, and led large-scale junior golf initiatives. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible for the Junior Golf Program?

In the first year of the program, launching in September 2025, the Golf Program will be open to boys and girls who are competitive/elite players in grades 7-12.

Will my son/daughter compete in tournaments?

Yes, students will compete in both single day and multiple day tournaments. For day trips, we will use a team bus for travel.

Are there extra costs for travel & tournaments?

Gear, practices, and tournament fees are included in tuition. However, parents are responsible for their own travel and accommodation fees where applicable.

How will my child be supported to balance their academic & athletic needs?

At Aspengrove, our teachers develop strong relationships with all of their students, and understand their individual needs. Strong communication between home and school is our strength - ensuring we work together to proactively balance your child's academic, athletic, and social needs.

Do you offer bus service?

Aspengrove owns 3 school buses and offers daily service from South Nanaimo to Qualicum. We can typically work with families to service their neighbourhood, if we aren't already doing so. (Not included in tuition fees.)
