- Consistently monitoring and tracking student progress toward academic and IEP goals.
- Communicating clearly, empathetically, and professionally with staff, students, and parents in person and via digital channels.
- Applying to the College Board for Accommodations for AP Exams.
- Participating in Senior School life activities, including supporting athletic events, clubs, or other co-curricular duties as required.
