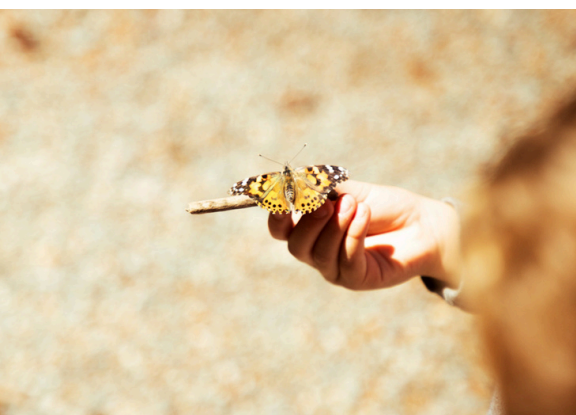
## Markers & Creators

How do you start your kids on the path to becoming fit, athletic, and agile? Teach them how to master movement!

Our Intro to Training program will build athletic strength through a neuromuscular training philosophy, based on training movement, and creating healthy fundamental motor patterns (running/skipping/sliding). Intro to Training is about building athletic movement, linked system strength, power, transitional balance, coordination, mind-muscle integration and sequential muscle firing from the inside out.

Coaches will identify and train up any weak links in the kinetic chain. Athletes will build core stability and strength, increase joint mobility and stability, and build full-body integrated strength. Additionally a large focus will be on run and sprint mechanics.

Our Strength & Development program uses a neuromuscular approach to build athletic movement from the inside out. We focus on strength, balance, coordination, muscle sequencing, and mind-body integration so athletes move efficiently, powerfully, and under control.

Through structured training, we restore the natural "play" movements young athletes often miss today, teaching fundamental motor patterns early to support long-term growth. Precision comes before speed - athletes master clean, repeatable movements before adding intensity.

By strengthening the brain-body connection, we enhance reaction, resilience, and overall athletic performance.

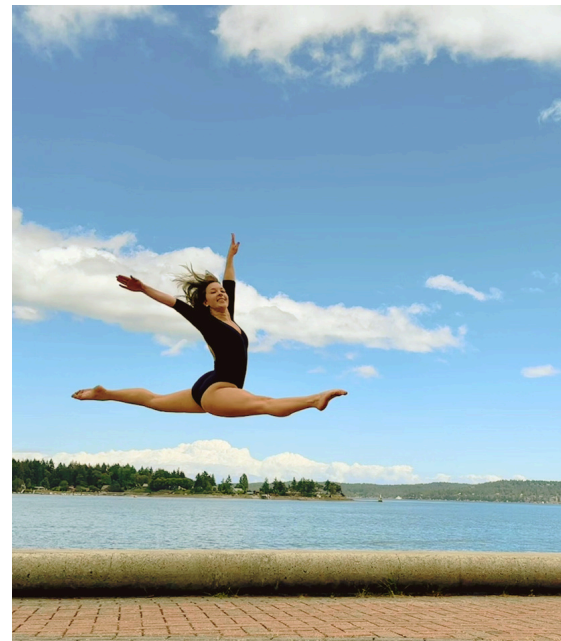

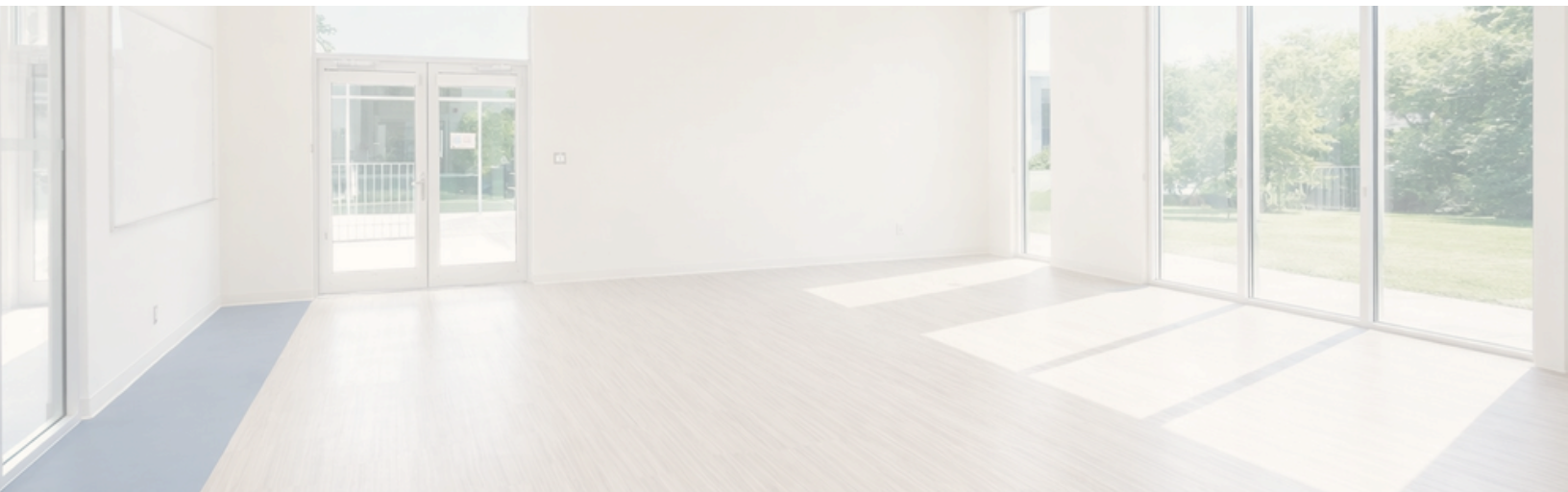
Welcome to our 6th Annual Summer Technique Intensive, designed for Ballet Academy dancers training at a pre-professional level.
