INTRODUCTION

At Aspengrove School, students are required to wear a uniform. School uniforms have been shown to contribute to a more focused learning environment. Uniforms can also be an important part of inclusion at Aspengrove as the goal for our students is to strive to be their best based on their actions rather than their appearance.

The updated uniform was designed to provide a West Coast style that remains professional yet comfortable while also recognizing our strong connection to the outdoors and our community. This update is intended to simplify the uniform, reducing the amount of pieces families need to purchase.

The purpose of Aspengrove School's Uniform Handbook is to provide students and families with an informative, instructional document detailing student uniform requirements from Junior Kindergarten through to Grade 12.

Complete regulation school uniform is required to be worn by all Aspengrove students during school hours. Students wear formal school uniforms on Mondays, during school outings (where appropriate), at special events, or when representing the school. Casual uniforms may be worn at all other times (or athletic wear when applicable). **Please make sure that all items of clothing are clearly marked with the student's full name.**

We ask that our students adhere to the uniform requirements and wear their uniforms with pride.

JUNIOR SCHOOL SHOE EXPECTATIONS

While shoe choices for the school uniform have become more flexible, styles of shoes that contain a prominent logo and/or are a combination of black and white (similar to those listed below) will not be accepted during formal or casual days. In addition, Crocs., Birkenstocks, and other open-toed shoes will not be accepted.



The Junior School **formal/casual** shoe must be a versatile, comfortable black shoe with minimal/discreet logos.

The below examples are considered acceptable as they are mono-coloured and contain a small, discrete logo.



MIDDLE & SENIOR SCHOOL SHOE EXPECTATIONS

As shoe choices for the school uniform have become more flexible, styles of shoes that contain some white are now suitable.

Cross, Birkenstocks, and other open-toed shoes will not be accepted.

The Middle/Senior School shoe must be a versatile, comfortable black shoe with minimal white accents/discreet logos.



OUTERWEAR OPTIONS

Aspengrove School offers students outerwear options that are acceptable for wearing between classes, on off-campus field trips, or wherever appropriate.

Outerwear must be left in lockers or cubbies when class is in session. It is not appropriate to wear outerwear (personal or Aspengrove branded) during classes.

The following outerwear can be purchased through O'Neills.

****Non-Aspengrove branded hoodies are not considered outerwear and cannot be worn during school hours. In addition, jackets must be removed and stored away when not outside (ie. jackets are not permitted to be worn during class time).***

THIRD-PARTY PURCHASES

As part of Aspengrove School's uniform, Khaki pants may be purchased through a third-party distributor. Khakis purchased from a third-party distributor **MUST** be similar to the following colours (Beige, Khaki and British Khaki colour range **ONLY**):

THIRD-PARTY PURCHASES CONT'D

In order to ensure consistency and formality, Aspengrove School prohibits the purchase of khaki pants that resemble cargo pants, capris, leggings, or jeggings. Khaki pants must not have rips in their design or elastic hems at the bottom of pant leg.



THIRD-PARTY PURCHASES CONT'D

In order to ensure consistency and formality, Aspengrove School prohibits the purchase of black leggings, patterned leggings, capris, or flared leggings. Leggings must be full-length and solid navy in colour with minimal branding and non-flared bottoms.

The images below will not be accepted.



NON-COMPLIANCE

During regular school hours, students must adhere to the previously outlined uniform guidelines. Additional items that are not listed on specific uniform pages are not permitted to be worn during school hours.

Middle and Senior School students are not permitted to wear Physical Education (PE) specific items during regular class time on casual days (ie. wearing gym shorts to class). Students in Middle and Senior School must change in and out of PE uniform.

Hats are not to be worn in the school or during class time. Hats are only permitted during recess or outdoor periods.

***Please Note** - Uniform bottoms must be worn as designed and may not be rolled, pinned, tucked, shortened, or otherwise altered during the school day. Kilts, skirts, skorts, and shorts must reach at least mid-thigh when standing naturally. Students may choose from the approved uniform bottom options, including pants, shorts or kilts, provided they are worn properly and respectfully. If the item no longer fits properly, students need to wear another approved uniform item.



FREE DRESS DAY

Once a month students will have a Free Dress Day provided they have made an effort to follow the general guidelines for wearing the uniform. Should students choose not to follow these guidelines, their privileges will be revoked.

At such times, jeans may be worn as long as they are clean and neat and not torn. T-shirts must have appropriate subject matter and be in good condition. No cutoffs, tank tops/spaghetti straps, or crop tops may be worn and excessive amounts of skin should not show. Hair and accessories must be in keeping with a workplace environment. Hats are not to be worn indoors.

PLEASE AVOID WEARING ITEMS SIMILAR TO THE FOLLOWING:



SPIRIT DAY

Throughout the year, Aspengrove School students will be encouraged to participate in 'Spirit Days' where they can wear their House Shirt (Ciammaichella, Digney, Ferg, Saunders) or a costume themed in the colour of their house (ie. red, yellow, green or blue) and participate in school-wide events to build excitement and community between grades.

Spirit/House Shirts are not permitted to be worn during regular scheduled classes or P.H.E.
